From The Preacher's Pen THE SEED: GOD'S WORD

The Bible teaches that life begins at the seed and growth proceeds only after the seed is planted and germinated (Luke 8:5-15). The Bible also teaches that every seed will only bring forth after its own kind (Gen. 1:12). Therefore, when Jesus referred to God's Word as being "the seed" (Luke 8:11), He was teaching that the Bible 1) is the only seed that can produce a Christian, and 2) if followed honestly, will only produce a Christian. No other book can produce a Christian. No other book can produce a Christian and the Bible will not produce anything but a Christian. The logical conclusion then, for someone who desires to be a follower of Christ, is to simply study God's Word and obey God's plan to save.

Since the Bible only makes Christians only, from whence do denominations come? Denominations are produced by man-made seeds or creed books. The Bible does not produce Baptists, Methodists, Presbyterians, etc. Man-made creed books are the seed which bring forth denominationalism. Consider the following table:
