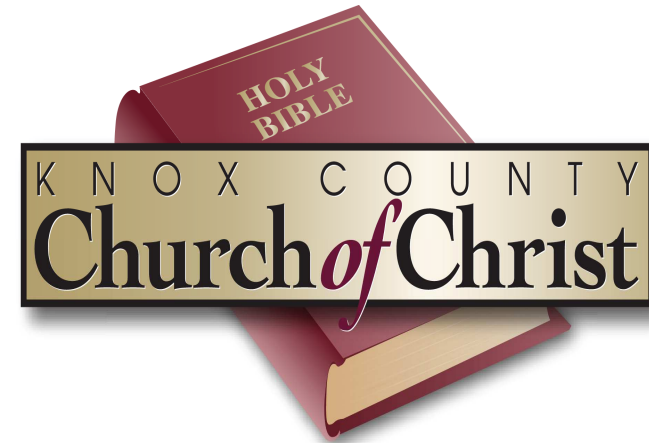

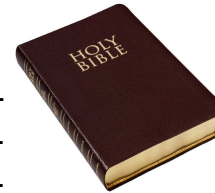
Welcome To The Knox County Church of Christ



Welcome to the Knox County Church of Christ. The Church of Christ is the “one body” (Ephesians 4:4; 1:22-23) which Jesus purchased with His blood (Acts 20:28). It is **NOT** a denomination. Jesus promised to build His Church (Matthew 16:18) and to do so while many of His disciples living in the 1st Century were still living (Mark 9:1). Jesus established His Church on the first Pentecost after His death, burial, and resurrection (Acts 2) and it is to that Church that God adds those who are being saved (Acts 2:38, 47). The Church of Christ has no creed except for the Bible, God’s Word (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:3). The Church of Christ exists today simply by following the pattern observed by the Church in the 1st Century. The Knox County Church of Christ is a local congregation of that “one body” that you read about in the New Testament.

WORSHIP

In worship, God authorized and commanded congregational **singing**, without the accompaniment of mechanical instruments (Ephesians 5:19), **prayer** (1 Thessalonians 5:17), **teaching/preaching** (1 Corinthians 4:17), partaking of the **Lord’s supper** (Acts 20:7), and **giving** (1 Corinthians 16:2).
