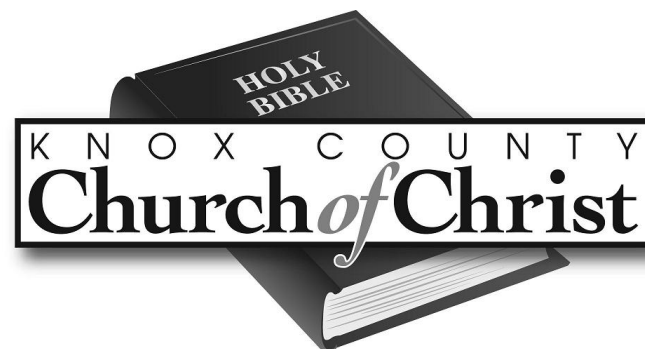

From The Preacher's Pen

“GOOD WORK”

On Sunday, October 11, the Knox County Church of Christ will be blessed to have brother Kent Bailey preach to us in our first One Day Gospel Meeting. We anticipate and eagerly await three Scriptural sermons that will edify, encourage, and lead us to actions harmonious with the word of God. At 9:30AM, brother Kent's sermon will be entitled, “Keeping The Proper Perspective In Life,” at 10:30 AM, “The Race Before Us,” and at 1:30 PM, “A Terrified King.”

For nearly six weeks now, we have been promoting this evangelistic opportunity. Newspaper ads are now running in the Knoxville News Sentinel and Loudon News Herald as the date quickly approaches. On Friday, October 2, several members (along with several children) helped pass out over 100 invitations in nearby neighborhoods. All members have been and continue to hand out and mail flyers to neighbors, friends, and co-workers. Let us pray fervently that this effort will bear fruit! We are involved in “Good Work!” Members of this congregation are like those in Nehemiah's day who “had a mind to work” (Neh. 4:6). While many in the Church sit idle and ask, “what can the Church do for me,” Christians with “a mind to work,” ask, “what can I do to further the Cause of Christ and bring glory to the Lord's Church?”. Jesus answers, “let your light so shine before men, that they may see your *good works*, and glorify your Father which is in heaven” (Mat. 5:16, emphasis B.G.). The apostle Paul states, “the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are His. And, Let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity. But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver,

but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour. If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the Master's use, and prepared unto every good work” (2 Tim. 2:19-21). It should be our desire to be “vessels of honour,” instruments of God here on Earth to do His will. It should also be our desire, not just to convert souls to Christ (Luke 19:10; Acts 3:19), but also to prepare those new Christians “unto every good work.” The Knox County Church of Christ has done this successfully. Not only are relatively new Christians involved in helping us spread the Gospel, young children are being “prepared” to become faithful Christians of the future as they walk side-by-side with an adult to invite someone to our Gospel Meeting. This is “Good Work.”

Our One Day Gospel Meeting is going to be successful. We will be encouraged in the Lord and will enjoy the fellowship. Visitors from our community may come to hear the soul-saving message of the Gospel (Rom. 1:16-17). Many more people will have heard about the Knox County Church of Christ. They may be intrigued and visit our website. They may read, for the first time, the Lord's plan of salvation which is printed on our flyers. We may not know what good has or will result from this present work in which we are involved. Some seed planted now may not produce fruit until some time in the future (Luke 8:15). This is why we simply need to be about our Father's business (Luke 2:49). Keep planting. Keep watering. Let God give the increase (1 Cor. 3:6). “Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto Him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever” (Rev. 5:13).
