

From The Preacher's Pen

“FOR THIS IS RIGHT”

“Mother’s Day” became a National holiday in 1914. It is celebrated each year on the second Sunday in May. Originally, the intent was for each family, individually, to honor their mother. This can be understood by the fact that the word “Mother’s” is singular possessive. Like most all holidays however, “Mother’s Day” has become highly commercialized. It is one of the biggest days for flower and greeting cards sales and television infomercials are raring to wrap a red ribbon around anything (including a George Foreman Indoor Grill) and call it “a perfect gift for ‘Mother’s Day’.”

The best way to honor our mothers is to be obedient to God. The Bible teaches, “children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right. Honour thy father and mother; (which is the first commandment with promise;) That it may be well with thee, and thou mayest live long on the earth” (Ephesians 6:1-3). Jesus gave honor to His mother as He went about doing the Will of God, the Father (Luke 2:49; John 19:26). How pleased Lois and Eunice (2 Timothy 1:5) must have been to know that Timothy had obeyed the Gospel of Christ (1 Timothy 1:2) and had become a preacher of the same (2 Corinthians 1:1). The wise man Solomon writes, “my son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother: For they shall be an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck” (Proverbs 1:8-9). While many consider crowns full of rare jewels and gold necklaces to signify prominence and honor, the inspired Solomon states that these physical “ornaments of grace” are nothing when compared to the value hearing and obeying the instruction of Godly parents. The Proverbs writer asks, “Who can find a virtuous woman? For her price is far above rubies” (Proverbs 31:10). The instruction of a Godly

mother is “far above rubies” as well. “There is gold, and a multitude of rubies: but the lips of knowledge are a precious jewel...For wisdom is better than rubies; and all the things that may be desired are not to be compared to it” (Proverbs 20:15; 8:11).

Let us bring honor to our mothers by honoring God with simple, humble, obedience to His Word.
