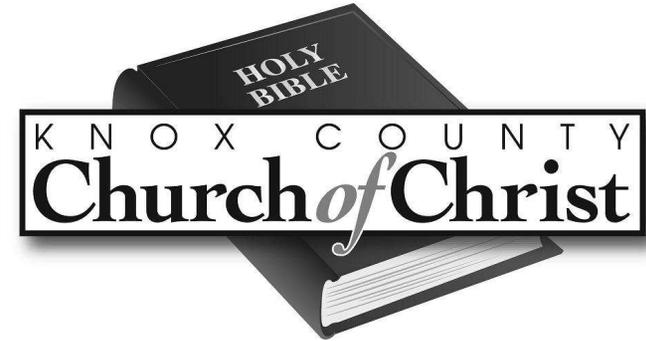

From The Preacher's Pen

“CHRISTIANITY COMES IN CANS”

It might interest some folks to know that they can get true Christianity in cans. I'm sure I've met some people along the way who would be glad to “get some religion” if they could just get it all wrapped up in a small, inexpensive package like a can. It doesn't come in that sort of can, but it does come in some cans. If you would be more than a pretending follower of Christ, you need these cans:

GET ALL YOU CAN. The people of the world (and far too many in the church) are already attempting this, but they are trying to get the wrong things. They seek material things, power, fame, fleshly pleasure, etc. Those who are serious about following Christ will seek other things. They will get all they can of knowledge of the Word of God, of fellowship with the saints, of spiritual strength and growth. Those who desire to get all they can of these things will never forsake the assembly, will make a time each day for Bible study and prayer, will go to lecture programs and workshops where they can learn, will read sound and wholesome books, etc. They will be so hungry and thirsty for Truth and the blessings it brings that they will find and use every source to get all they can. Many do not follow Christ very closely because they have neglected the very avenues of spiritual growth.

SAVE ALL YOU CAN. Many people are doing this, but they are saving the wrong things. Some folks save everything they get their hands on. Some literally starve themselves of needed food

to be able to save a few more dollars. If some Christians would be as concerned about the important things as they are about saving money and other perishables it would almost cause a revolution. If we would be true to the example and teaching of Christ, we must save all the souls we can, starting with our own. Parents must do their best to save their children. We all have other family members we should try to save. We must seek to save all of our friends that we can. No, we will never save them all, but who knows which ones we can until we try? The Lord will not necessarily judge us by the number we save, but he will certainly judge us by the effort we made to save all we can.

GIVE ALL YOU CAN. Some people are doing this for their careers, a sports event, a civic club, a political party or some other cause. Again, if some would give as much to the Lord and His work as they do to some secular causes, it would make drastic improvements in what we could accomplish. I speak not merely of the giving of money, but the gift of self. The essence of the discipleship is self denial, service, putting the kingdom first, and willingness to suffer for the sake of Christ. Such saints will not be stingy with their money, time or talent. Neither do they have to be begged to give!


