

From The Preacher's Pen

“WHERE ARE YOU LIVING?”

The Bible makes an interesting comment about Moses and his burial. The Word of God says, “So Moses the servant of the Lord died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the Lord. And he buried him in a valley in the land of Moab, over against Beth-peor: but no man knoweth of his sepulchre unto this day” (Deu. 35:5-6). What we know about Moses is that he died, but no one knew where his sepulcher was or is. A contrast to this is about David and his burial. The Bible says, “Men *and* brethren, let me freely speak unto you of the patriarch David, that he is both dead and buried, and his sepulchre is with us unto this day” (Acts 2:29). Peter says that David died and we know where his sepulcher is, even to this day.

I thought this was interesting from the standpoint that it really does not matter where our “sepulcher” is. We raise tombstones to mark the graves so that people will know where people are buried. However, time and events cause those markers to decay or disappear. Some of the floods have taken care of many of the caskets in some graves yards. In the area where I live, and no doubt all areas, there are graves that have markers that are barely readable, some not legible, because of time and weather. This leads to the conclusion that it really does not matter where one’s “sepulcher” is.

Well, then, what does matter? What matters is where one lives? No, not Virginia or Michigan—but whether one lives in harmony with God or

not, that is what really matters! Amos wrote, in the long ago, “Can two walk together, except they be agreed?” (Amos 3:3). Moses was in agreement with God. Yes, Moses sinned in unbelief—he was, after all, human. It was because of this sin that Moses was not allowed to enter the land of promise, but died and was buried in sight of the land. David was in agreement with God. Yes, David sinned; he was human, but he was a man after God’s own heart.

We, today, either live in the kingdom of Christ or the kingdom of darkness; there is no “gray area.” Paul put it this way, “Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated *us* into the kingdom of his dear Son” (Col. 1:13). We are either in the power (kingdom) of darkness or in Christ’s kingdom. This is what matters, not where your sepulcher is.

Beloved, all of us will go to our sepulcher, unless Christ returns—then we will be changed. But where you are buried is not the question; where you are living is!

Beloved, where are you living? Beloved, listen to all of God’s Word, God will do thee good.
